1. Schedule of the Competition:

Thursday May 5th:

- 17h00 – 21h00: weapons control, registration and payment of entries at the official hotel.

Friday May 6th: individual event

- 07h30: weapons control
- 10h00: beginning of round of pools
- followed by: preliminary table of 128

Saturday May 7th: individual event

- 07h30: weapons control opening
- 10h00: beginning table of 64

Sunday May 8th: Team event

- 07h00: weapons control opening
- 09h00: beginning team's table

2. Participation

For Individual World Cup competitions, each national federation may enter a maximum of 12 fencers. The organising country may enter up to 20 fencers plus the number needed to make up the pools.

Team participation is open to all countries and limited to one team per weapon per country.

3. Entry

Every competitor is required to be licensed for the 2021-2022 season.

No fencer is allowed to take part in an official event of the FIE unless he or she is at least 13 years old on 1 January in the year of the competition.

Entries of fencers, teams and referees can only be made at the FIE website, www.fie.org, respecting the deadlines specified in the FIE Rules (cf. o.54).

4. Entry fee

Individual competition: **EUR 60**. Team competition: **EUR 400**.

The entry fee can be paid at registration before the start of the competition.

5. Referee Obligation

The referees are designated by the FIE and delegations will not have to provide any referees.

6. Formula

Individual competitions – One qualifying round of pools, a preliminary direct elimination table, a main direct elimination table of 64 fencers to qualify for a final by direct elimination.

Team competitions – Integral direct elimination with a direct elimination table which may be incomplete. All places in the table up to 16th place will be fought for. From 17th place onwards teams will be classified, within each round of the table, according to their initial place in the table. The first four teams will be placed in the direct elimination table according to the current official team ranking of the FIE (cf. o.86); the remaining ranked teams will be placed in the table by drawing of lots in pairs. The teams that are not classified will occupy the last places in the table, and will be separated by drawing of lots (cf. o.42-o.47).

7. Doping

Doping control will be done according to FIE rules.

10. Covid Protocol

10.1 Entry in Spain:

All passengers arriving in Spain by air or sea, including those coming in transit to other countries, must complete a Health Control Form before departure and obtain their QR to present it at boarding and health controls on arrival in Spain:

- By air: via the website <https://spth.gob.es> or the Spain Travel Health -SpTH- application (Android, iOS).

In addition to the Health Control Form, passengers must present a certificate or document certifying vaccination, diagnostic test for active infection (PDIA), or recovery from COVID-19. These certificates will be different if issued in the European Union (EU Digital COVID Certificate) or a third country.

COVID-19 certificates of vaccination, diagnostic tests, or recovery issued by countries with which the EU has established equivalence will have the same status as an EU DCC. These countries can be consulted on the European Union (EU) website

The accepted vaccines are those produced by Pfizer-Biotech, Moderna, Astra-Zeneca, Jansen / Johnson & Johnson, Sinovac, and Sinopharm, which are those that, at the moment, are authorized by the European Medicines Agency or are included in the list of use of emergency of the World Health Organization

The Spanish High Council of Sports will issue the corresponding certificate if an athlete does not have any of these documents (vaccine or diagnostic test or COVID recovery certificate) and meets the requirements. For that purpose, we will need the following data:

- name and surname,
- passport number,
- and country from which you are traveling.

10.2 COVID19 Protocol:

Following the rules of the Spanish government and applying the FORMIR guidelines of the FIE, the following protocol will be enforced:

1. Rapid Antigen Test (RAT)

Every participant must undergo a Rapid Antigen Test (RAT). The tests are free to athletes, coaches and referees. Supplementary people must pay for the tests (25 €).

Identification of tested people is made via a bracelet. Losing the bracelet will require retesting for a fee (25€).

Also, note that the validity of the RATs done at the competition is only valid for the event.

Tests will be done on:

- Thursday 05/05/22 between 13:00 and 20:00
- Friday 06/05/22 between 07:30 and 11:00
- Saturday 07/05/22 between 07:30 and 11.00

Also, please bring the filled and signed “Appendix B” (COVID-19 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISK AND RELEASE FROM LIABILITY) and “Appendix C” (COVID-19 SCREENING QUESTIONNAIRE FOR FIE EVENT) of the FIE outline of risk-mitigation requirements.

2 . Departure Test

If you need a departure PCR, you will need to make a reservation with the OC. The tests cost 90€ and will be at your charge.

Tests will be done on Friday 06/05/22 between 13:00 and 17:00 (results available before 09:00 next day) and Saturday 07/05/22 between 09:00 and 15:00 (results available before 09:00 the next day).

To guarantee that we will handle the required testing volume, you need to obligatory communicate the number of the tests needed by April 29th, 2022.

We will then confirm this number and send you a form where you will need to put in the names of the people to be tested. You will need to send us this form by April 29th, 2022 latest.

If you need a departure RAT (Rapid Antigen Test) with certificate, you will need to make a reservation with the OC. The tests cost 25€ and will be at your charge.

Tests will be done on Friday 06/05/22 between 13:00 and 17:00, Saturday 07/05/22 between 09:00 and 15:00 and Sunday between 09:00 and 13:00 (results available in 15 minutes).

No test can be guaranteed that had not been registered within the deadlines.

The Laboratory EUROFINS MEGALAB conducts departure tests.

3. Positive RAT

The OC must transmit the entire dataset of every person who tested positive to the authorities. Legislation requires that persons tested positive be isolated immediately.

If a RAT is positive, the tested person must immediately go to his room. A PCR test will be done to control the result of the RAT.
